

Appeal for contributions to the Bursary Fund

It is essential to the nature of the UK Deanery's Conference and Festival - as the reflection of the whole body of the church - that everyone who wishes to, regardless of financial status, should be able to attend. Prices at the Conference Centre are fair, but are higher than many are able to afford. We will have to raise a substantial Bursary Fund to make attendance possible for those who cannot afford the full conference fee. We have the difficult - but God-given - task to try to make this possible, to be creative in a situation which continues to be challenging: each one of us can play a part, no matter how small. Therefore we hope and ask that those of you who are able will give as generously as possible to the Bursary Fund.

As we are a registered charity, we can reclaim Gift Aid. If you are a UK taxpayer, and have paid enough Income or Capital Gains tax to cover the tax reclaimed, any donations you make can be increased by making a Gift Aid declaration; this adds 28% to your donation, at no extra cost to yourself; *for example - a donation of £20 will bring an extra £5.64, or £25 will bring £7.05.* (If you are a higher rate taxpayer you may be able to recover further tax through your own tax return.)
